Bus beheader thought victim was an alien

WINNIPEG — A supporter of the man who beheaded a fellow passenger on a Greyhound bus in Manitoba says the man thought he was attacking an alien.
 Vince Li has granted an interview to Chris Summerville, head of the Manitoba Schizophrenia Society, who says Li has been treated unfairly by the public and the media.
 Summerville says Li told him he heard voices that said fellow passenger Tim McLean was an alien who had to be killed to protect other passengers.
 Li is a schizophrenic and was found not criminally responsible for the crime.
 He has been confined to a mental hospital, but last week was granted the right to escorted trips off the hospital grounds and into Selkirk, Manitoba.
 Summerville says that Li told him during the 45-minute interview that took place over the weekend, that he understands the importance of staying on medication and would like forgiveness from the victim's family.
 Li took out a knife and attacked McLean, a stranger who was sitting beside him on the bus, in July 2008.

Kelowna woman threatened with explosives during hostage ordeal

KAMLOOPS, B.C. — A woman taken hostage in her Kamloops, B.C., home last week before an explosion and blaze killed a man says he tormented her for hours.
 Forty-four-year-old Sherry Young told radio station CFJC that she knew 48-year-old Dennis Crosby only as a former colleague from work and was not his ex-girlfriend as reported earlier.
 Young says she, her boyfriend and their children were arriving home Thursday when Crosby forced his way in and his gun went off.
 The boyfriend and children managed to escape, but Young says Crosby made her watch a video of test explosions he'd conducted involving a type of explosive device similar to one he had strapped to his chest.
 Crosby eventually released Young and set off explosives that killed him and caused a fire that destroyed her home.
